



4-Day Trip Itinerary

Chickasaw County

The Outdoors Weekend

DAY 1

Afternoon: Arrive in Chickasaw County and get settled at your campsite or lodging.

Evening: Head to Cedar Lake in Nashua for an evening on the water. Depending on the season, enjoy boating, fishing, kayaking or simply take in the view.

Dinner: Grab dinner in Nashua at Big Willie's and finish the evening with a walk around town. Stay the night in Nashua.

Cedar Lake offers boating, water skiing, jet skiing, tubing and fishing, while Cedar View Park provides waterfront camping and boat access.

DAY 3

Morning: Get breakfast at Klunder's in New Hampton and spend your morning at Airport Lake north of New Hampton. Bring your fishing gear, kayak, or just find a spot to relax by the water.

Afternoon: After lunch in New Hampton, walk or bike on the Tribe Trail. Enjoy close to six miles of paved, concrete trail that runs from one side of New Hampton to the other. On the trail, you can access many community amenities such as the Chickasaw Wellness Complex, Mikkelson Park, and Garnant Pond.

Evening: Grab pizza or broasted chicken at Poor Richards across from Mikkelson Park and enjoy one last night around the campfire.

DAY 2

Morning: Grab breakfast and a coffee at Roosters on Main. Start your day at Twin Ponds Nature Center near Ionia. Explore the 157-acre area, hike the trails and keep an eye out for birds and other wildlife.

Lunch at the Hide-A-Way Lounge in Ionia.

Afternoon: Head to Fredericksburg and explore the Plum Creek Bike & Nature Trail. The trail runs for more than five miles along Plum Creek and is great for walking or biking.

Evening: Dinner in Fredericksburg at Pizza Palace, followed by a relaxing evening at your campground or lodging.

Stay the night in Fredericksburg or Nashua. Twin Ponds has hiking, fishing, camping, educational displays and bird watching, while the Plum Creek trail offers more than five miles of scenic walking and biking.

DAY 4

Before heading home, squeeze in one more walk, fishing spot or park visit.

Want to stay longer? Add another night of camping or explore more of Chickasaw County's parks and trails.
